EMBLEM

The University emblem consisting of two concentric circles, with the inner circle divided into two halves, one half showing the rising sun the other depicting the waters and a hundred petalled lotus emanating there from symbolises the biunity of knowledge and action, whole and part and time eternity. The Rigvedic hymn in the space between the upper circumferences of the two circles is a prayer to all powers auspicious, and an invocation of all intentions noble, all actions good and all wisdom serene.

The circle, the sun, the waters and the lotus in the emblem are all archetypes of wholeness. The mandala is a familiar motive of Indian art and iconography. The vedic supernal sun and the surface of the mythic lotus are circular in shape (mandalakara).

The supernal sun is verily the Person (Purusha) the Divine Being, the all-whole, divided into four part, one representing the three worlds of earth. sky and space (bhutani) and the remaining three, that is the major part representing Heaven and Immortality (amritam divi). It is this all-whole (akhanda mandalakaram) that the part (ams'a), that is man, perennially craves to unite with, through right knowledge and right action (Karatub).

The vedic hymn then expresses nothing more nor less than the universal human yearning for right knowledge, right intentions and right action (bhadrah kratavo) to come to him from all cosmic and supra cosmic corners. And it is this ideal of right intention that they seek to inculcate among their alumni.

The lotus is again the seat and seed-bed, in Indian mythology, of the goddess of knowledge (saraswati). The waters are the ultimate source from which all manifestations proceed and are appropriately depicted in myth and art as the residue(shesha), the irreducible unknown and unshown to which everything known and shown can be reduced. The residue (shesha) is analogically the non-residual (ashesha), the endless whole(ananta).

The traditional art motifs reproduced in the emblem only intend to express and reinforce the symbolism of the vedic hymn which our founding fathers had rightly selected as our motto.

Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm.):

D. Pharm is a TWO year professional program. In addition, there shall be a five hundred hours of hospital training spread over not less than three months after completion of the second-year course curriculum.

Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.):

B. Pharm. is a FOUR year (8 semester) professional program. In this 4 years programme, students will be provided various training programs, like hospital and industrial training. In the 5th and 7th semesters, hospital training program in health care services, while in the 6th semester industrial training program and in the 8th semester industrial visits program as per PCI Norms.

D. Pharm. & B. Pharm. Course Objectives:

- Helping pharmacy graduates gain theoretical and practical knowledge towards drug discovery and development.
- Build solid foundations and excellent technological expertise to excel in the various sectors of the pharmaceutical industry and research organizations.
- Prepare pharmacists to meet the pharmacy profession's challenges and contribute effectively to the social health care system.
- To foster the development of future pharmacists' leadership and entrepreneurship skills. Enhance the knowledge of the formulation and dispensing of oral and parenteral route medicines.
- To investigate the synthetic and herbal drugs for their possible pharmacological activities.

Core Courses:

- Pharmacology: Study of effects and mechanisms of drugs.
- Pharmaceutical Chemistry: Knowledge of chemical aspects of drug design and synthesis.
- Pharmaceutics: Study of drug information, formulation and delivery.
- Pharmacognosy: Study of medicinal plants and natural products.
- Biochemistry: To understand the biochemical processes related to drug action in living body.

Practical courses and Training:

Laboratory work of all core courses, internships, and industry visits.

Career Opportunities:

- Clinical Pharmacist: Working in hospitals to raise patient medication use.
- Pharmacist: Dispensing medications and counselling the use of medication.
- Research Scientist: Based on project work related to drug development and testing.
- Quality Control Analyst: Ensuring drug safety and efficacy through analytical work.
- Entrepreneurship: Starting and managing a business with the goal of creating value, being innovative, and promoting pharmaceutical products.

Pharmaceutical Sciences:

Pharmaceutical Sciences is a multidisciplinary field of study that emphasis on the discovery, development, production, and regulation of drugs and medications to improve health and treat diseases. It syndicates principles from various scientific disciplines such as chemistry, biology, pharmacology, biotechnology, and medicine.

Laboratory Sciences:

It involves using laboratory techniques to analyses biological samples (like blood or tissue) to assist in diagnosis and treatment. This comprises fields like medical laboratory technology and pathology.

Clinical Practice:

Clinical Practice involves applying medical knowledge to diagnose, treat, and manage patient care. This can include hands-on patient interactions and working within healthcare teams.

Public Health:

Focuses on understanding disease prevention, health inclinations and health promotion in populations. This can involve health education, epidemiology, and community health initiatives.

Health Informatics:

Assimilates information technology and data analysis in healthcare settings to improve patient care, streamline processes, and enhance research capabilities.

Eligibility

The eligibility criteria for students who want to pursue a D. Pharm. / B. Pharm. course at the D.D.U. Gorakhpur University are:

1. Minimum qualification for admission – Must have passed/appearing in 10+2 examination (Science academic stream) with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology or Mathematics with a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate and minimum qualifying marks in relevant entrance exams.
2. Students should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the program.
OR
3. Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to the above examination, with minimum qualifying marks in relevant entrance exams.
4. Lateral: Admission qualification for lateral entry to B. Pharm 3rd Semester shall be a pass[#] in D. Pharm from an institution approved by the PCI u/s 12 of Pharmacy Act, 1948. (10% of intake)
5. Students who secure top general ranks in the entrance examination will be eligible for the TFW seats (5% of intake). Students availing the TFW scheme will not be eligible for any other scholarship/financial assistance from the government or any other agency.

M. Pharm Course Overview

The program of study for M.Pharm shall extend over a period of four semesters (two academic years). The curricula and syllabi for the program shall be prescribed from time to time by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi.



Minimum Qualification for Admission

- a) B. Pharm Degree examination of an Indian university established by law in India from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India and has scored not less than 55 % of the maximum marks (aggregate of 4 years of B.Pharm.)
- b) Every student, selected for admission to post graduate pharmacy program in any PCI approved institution should have obtained registration with the State Pharmacy Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of his/her admission, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.

Eligibility Criteria

2-year/4-semester Master's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.

2. Candidates need to apply separately for admission to each program. Application in one program will not be transferred in any case to another program.

Entrance Test

- The B. Pharm/D. Pharm. Entrance Test shall consist of 100 multiple-choice questions of the Intermediate examination level of all recognized Education Board.
- The Test shall be of two hours duration.
- Each question shall carry 02 marks and the total marks would be 200. No marks shall be deducted for a incorrect answer in the Test.
- Except for the questions on languages, all other questions shall be both in English and Hindi language.

General Instructions and Admission Procedure

1. The details and admission procedure of all the programs is available on the University website www.ddugu.ac.in.
2. The eligible applicants can fill the online application form available on the website for appearing in the Entrance Test 2025-26.
3. Applicants who qualify the Entrance Test and fulfill minimum required eligibility criteria will be given provisional admission according to their ranks in the merit list which is prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance Test, Weightage marks and availability of the seats in conformity with the rules of reservation.

4. List of the provisionally qualified applicants will be made available on the university website. Thereafter, applicants will have to appear before the Faculty/Departmental Admission Committee with all their original documents. The concerned officials, then, will complete the admission process. Thereafter, applicants will have to confirm their admission by depositing their fee through Net Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card etc. within the stipulated timeframe. They will have to get themselves registered in the respective programs within three days from the time of their fee submission. If they fail to submit their fee in time, their admission will be cancelled, and those seats will be assigned to the applicants next in the merit list.
 5. At the time of admission, the applicant himself/herself will have to produce all the original documents (Mark Sheets, Caste Certificate, Weightage Certificate/ Ex.Serviceman/ Dependent Freedom Fighter/Kashmiri Migrant/ Kargil Martyr, Handicapped Certificate, Transfer Certificate, Latest Character Certificate issued by the last institution where he/she has received education, EWS Certificate etc.) together with one set of self-attested photocopies of these before the Admission Committee. Applicants who have passed their qualifying examination as a private student will have to submit their certificates by getting them attested by any teacher at the University or any Gazetted officer or any M.L.A. or M.P. Their selection will be automatically cancelled if they do not produce the required documents.
 6. Applicants, who have passed the qualifying examination prior to 2025, will have to produce an affidavit stating reasons for their gap at the time of admission. The Admission Committee will allow such an applicant after thorough verification of the facts mentioned in the affidavit.
 7. If any applicant fails to present himself/herself on the prescribed dates with all his/her original documents, he/she will not be given any further chance.
 8. Applicants will have to bring their Entrance Test Admit Card at the time of admission; therefore, it is advised to keep the Admit Card safe.
 9. It will be necessary for the selected applicants to get themselves registered in the concerned Department after depositing the required fee before the prescribed date otherwise their admission will be cancelled. An applicant will be considered a regular student at the University from the time of his/her registration in the concerned Department after the payment of the required fee.
 10. Category, sub-category or weightage certificates issued by the competent authorities will have to be produced in original at the time of admission. Alteration of any sort, at later stages, will not be permissible.
 11. For the benefit of reservation, applicants will have to bring Caste and Income certificates issued within the time period of three years from the date of admission.
 12. Once admitted and having appeared/failed/intercepted in the examination of a particular class in the University, a student shall not be readmitted. Having appeared/failed students can appear as Ex-student.

13. Admission in any of the class of the University will not be permitted on the basis of transfer from any College of the University or from any other University.
14. The University reserves the right to cancel or deny the admission of any applicant without citing the reasons. It also reserves the right to make circumstantial changes in the rules of the admission process in order to make it more convenient.
15. All the documents related to the Entrance Test will be preserved for a period of six months from the date of Entrance Test.
16. Admission instructions are devised according to the University Act, Statutes and Ordinances.
17. If any contingent situation arises at the time of admission, it will be sorted out according to the decision of the Admission Committee.

Important and relevant instructions for the Entrance Test

1. The OMR answer sheet will be given along with the question booklet, on which the answer will have to be marked. Only the answer sheet (OMR) will be evaluated.
2. Each question will have four alternative answers, out of which candidates have to choose the correct answer by shading the circle of the choice with black /blue ball pen against that question number.

1- Who is the author of 'Hind Swaraj'?

- B. Mahatma Gandhi
- C. Subhash Chandra Bose
- D. Bal Ganga Dhar Tilak

2. Select the word with the correct spelling:

- A. Psichology

- D. Psychlogy

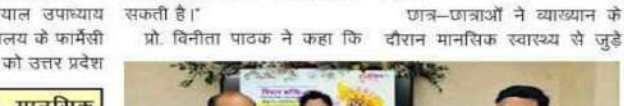
